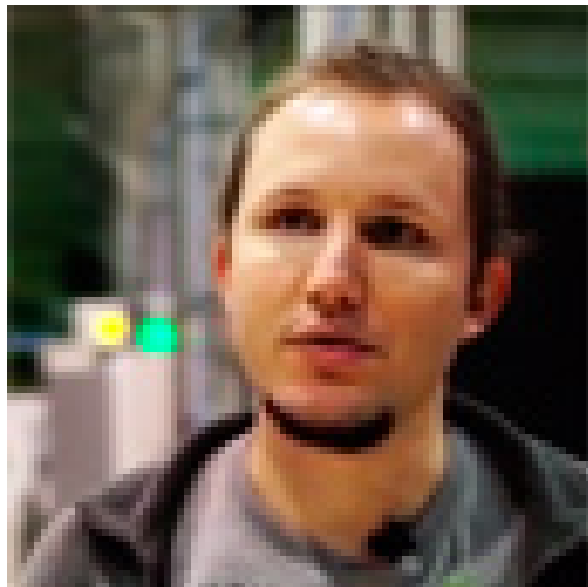
Markus Appel, a German doctoral student, chose to carry out his research in the Grenoble Laue-Langevin Institute on the June 23, 2014
